**Jefferson County Republican Party’s Statement on the Request for a
Bipartisan Audit Instead of Certifying the 2020 Canvass**

Jefferson County, CO. – After the 2020 Election, concerns remain with the Dominion software that is used across Colorado and here in Jefferson County. Because all voters deserve transparency and accountability in our elections and because of dramatic statistical differences that exist, the Minority Report filed today requests a bipartisan audit of the Dominion software code.

“We are not filing this Minority Report to allege election fraud,” stated Denise Mund, Jefferson County Republican Chairwoman. “We appreciate the willingness of the Jeffco Clerk’s office to answer our questions whenever possible. However, we also believe the public would benefit from a more thorough audit of the 2018 and 2020 election results that specifically includes a transparent review of Dominion’s software code.” Jeffco began using the Dominion software in 2017.

The Minority Report is available here in its entirety, along with the seven specific requests being made. Chairwoman Mund stated, “Every voter in Jefferson County should be able to have complete confidence in our elections, no matter which candidates they support. This transcends party lines and is a foundation of American democracy.”
